Late preference change requests:

- Parents/Carers of children wishing to make a change of preference should contact the LA by emailing schooladmissions@halton.gov.uk or visiting any of the Halton Direct Link Offices **by no later than 5pm on Friday 15th March**. The LA will then contact the parent/carer of any child for whom a new preference can be offered by Friday 22nd March. Parents/Carers who are unsuccessful in their request for a new preference for their child are entitled to the right of appeal and will be notified of this in writing. The names of any children who are unsuccessful in application will **automatically** be placed on the waiting list for the school (s) and these lists will be ranked in accordance with the school's oversubscription criteria and are maintained by the local authority until 31st December 2019 under the agreed coordinated admissions scheme.
- Late preference change requests received after Friday 15th March will be processed after Friday 22nd March on an 'as-received' basis at our earliest opportunity.
