### Local Authorities (Referendums) (Petitions) (England) Regulations 2011

#### Verification number for a petition for a different form of governance

Notice is hereby given that:

1. David Parr, Electoral Registration Officer and Proper Officer for the purposes of the above Regulations, has published the petition verification number that is equal to 5% of the number of local government electors shown in the electoral register in force for the period commencing on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2020.
2. The number for the said purpose is 4852;
3. The number will be used for the purposes of determining the validity of petitions presented after 31 March 2020 and before 1 April 2021, seeking a referendum on whether or not there should be an elected mayor or alternative constitutional model, unless the circumstances mentioned in paragraph 4 below apply.
4. If the number for 2021, to be published in February 2021, is less than 4852, that lower number will be used for the purpose of determining the validity of petitions presented between the date the number is published and 31 March 2021.
5. The number that will be used for the purposes of determining the validity of petitions presented before 31 March 2020, is 4852.
