

Emergency Instructions

If you become aware of a major emergency or hear the warning siren*:



1. Go immediately into a house or building.
2. Close all external doors and windows and keep away from windows.
3. Switch off fresh air and air conditioning systems.
4. Stay in a room away from the industrial area.
5. If possible, go to an upper floor.
6. DO NOT collect children from school or early years settings - they will be properly cared for.
7. Tune into Radio Merseyside (95.8 MHz FM, 202m/1485 KHz AM), Radio City (96.7 MHz FM, 194m/1548 KHz AM) or Wire FM (107.2 FM), which will be used to broadcast emergency information or instructions.
8. Avoid using the telephone or mobile telephones until the emergency is over to ensure lines are free for the emergency services.
9. Co-operate fully with the instructions given by the emergency services.
10. Remain indoors until the emergency is over when the doors and windows should be opened to restore ventilation.



* FOR YOUR INFORMATION

A '**warning**' is given by three short blasts on the sirens. This warning will be sounded periodically (e.g. approximately every 15 minutes) throughout a major emergency. The '**all clear**' is confirmed by a single long blast. Tests on the sirens are done weekly on a Monday at 1300hrs and are characterised by one short blast.
