



EMERGENCY ADVICE FROM UNIVAR LIMITED

This card is produced in accordance with the Control of Major Accident Hazards (COMAH) Regulations 1999 to advise you on what to do in the unlikely event of an accident at our premises that could affect you and people near you. COMAH Regulations 1999 ensure that businesses like ours take all necessary measures to prevent major accidents involving dangerous substances and to limit the consequences of any such accidents for people and the environment.

Please read this card carefully.

- Make sure everyone in your property knows and understands these instructions.
- Keep this card in an accessible place and pass it on to subsequent residents or occupiers.
- Display this card in a prominent place if you are in business or community premises.

Alarm siren and testing

To ensure you are aware of the siren, **tests** will be made on the first Friday of each month, with a **single blast at 10.00am**.

If a major accident happens at Univar, you will hear the emergency alarm siren.

- The **alarm will be sounded with 3 short blasts** sounded periodically (approximately every 15 minutes) throughout any major emergency.
- The **all clear** is confirmed with a single long tone.

- **GO IN** immediately if you hear **three short blasts** on the alarm siren
 - Shut all outside doors and windows
 - Pull curtains or blinds across windows facing the Univar site
 - Turn off any ventilation system or air conditioning unit that draws in air from the outside.
- **STAY IN** a room that does not face the Univar site.
- **TUNE IN** to local radio, which will broadcast information and instructions.

- If you have children at a nearby school or nursery, **DO NOT** collect them. They will be looked after until it's safe to go outside.
- Avoid using the telephone until the emergency is over, to ensure lines are free for the emergency services.
- Please do not call the Univar site or the emergency services. **DO TUNE IN** to local radio for updates and advice.
- Please co-operate fully with any instructions given by the emergency services.
- Remain indoors until you hear the 'all clear' siren or until you receive instructions from the radio station or Cheshire Police. The 'all clear' siren will mean it is safe for you to go outside.

For your safety, access to the area will be restricted during a major accident.
