Please read this card carefully

- ◇ Make sure everyone in your property knows and understands these instructions.
- ◇ Keep this card in an accessible place and pass it on to the subsequent occupiers.
- ◇ Display this card in a prominent place.

Alarm siren and testing

To ensure that you are aware of the siren, tests will be made on the first Wednesday of every month at 10 a.m.

If there is a **Major Accident** at Emerald Kalama Chemicals Ltd, you will hear the alarm. The siren will be sounded every 5 minutes until the situation is resolved and the all clear siren is used.

Further Information

- ◇ Go indoors. Local schools, nurseries, homes for the elderly and vulnerable and other community facilities will be prepared for this situation. Do not leave your home or work to collect children or go outside.
- ◇ Do not call Emerald Kalama Chemical Ltd, the emergency services or TV and radio stations as these lines need to be kept free for emergency use.
- ◇ In the event of a major accident, please co-operate with the emergency services and follow their instructions and advice.

GO IN immediately if you hear the wailing alarm siren.

- ◇ Close all doors and windows
- ◇ Close any other ventilation
- ◇ Switch off gas appliances, do not light matches or start engines

STAY IN a room that does not face Emerald Kalama Site, if this is not possible move away from windows that face the site.

TUNE IN to local radio which will broadcast information and instructions
