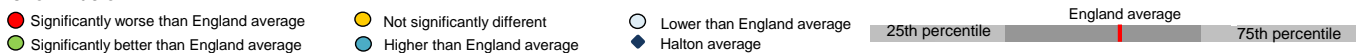


Summary of child health and well-being

The local result for each indicator is shown as a circle, against the range of results for England which are shown as a grey bar. The red line indicates the England average.
